You can enter from Amalias Avenue and exit onto Irodou Attikou Street, where you will find the Maximos Mansion (Prime Minister's Residence) and the Presidential Mansion. Another exit leads directly to the Panathenaic Stadium.

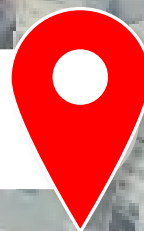


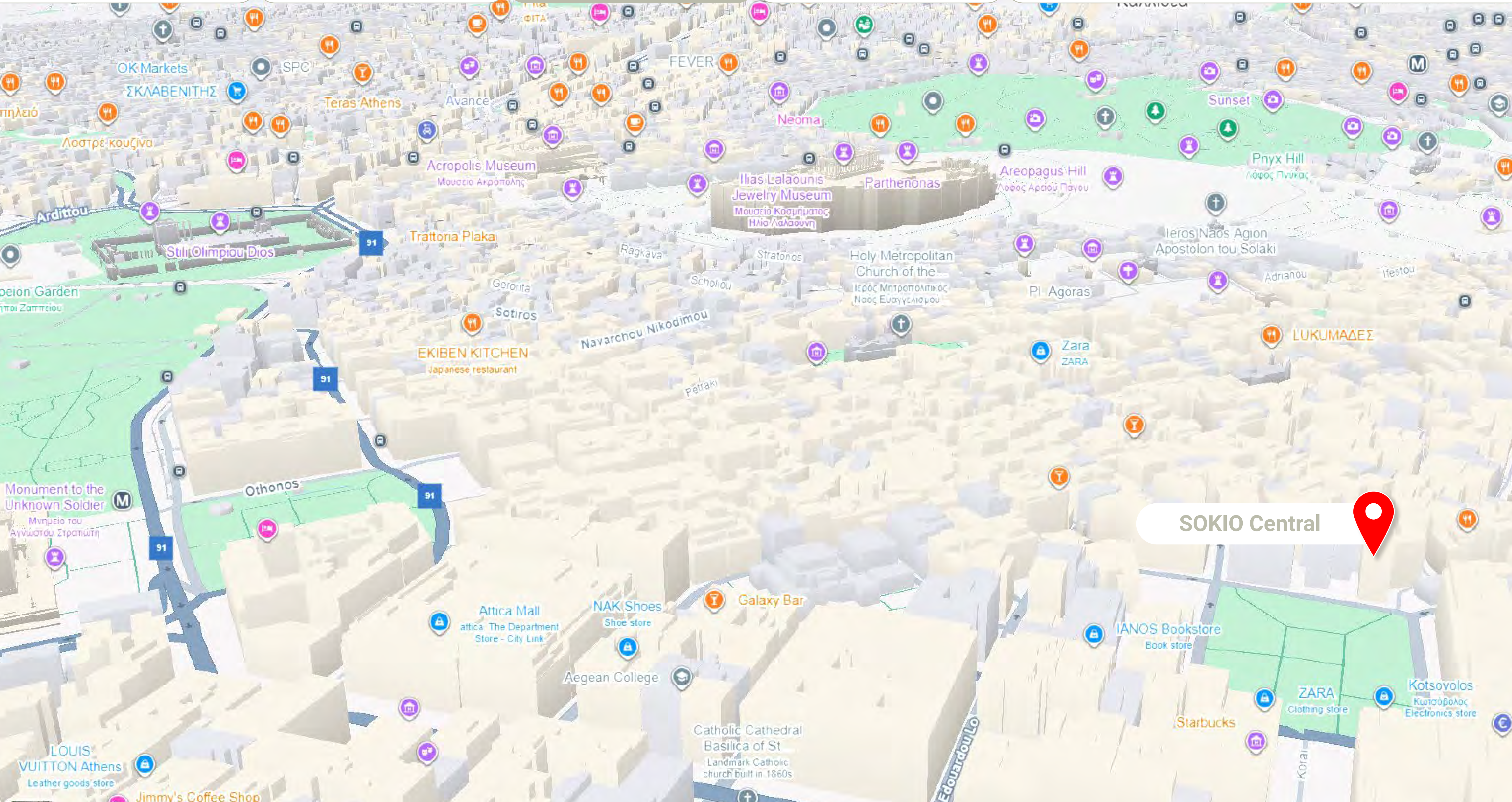

Maria Callas museum

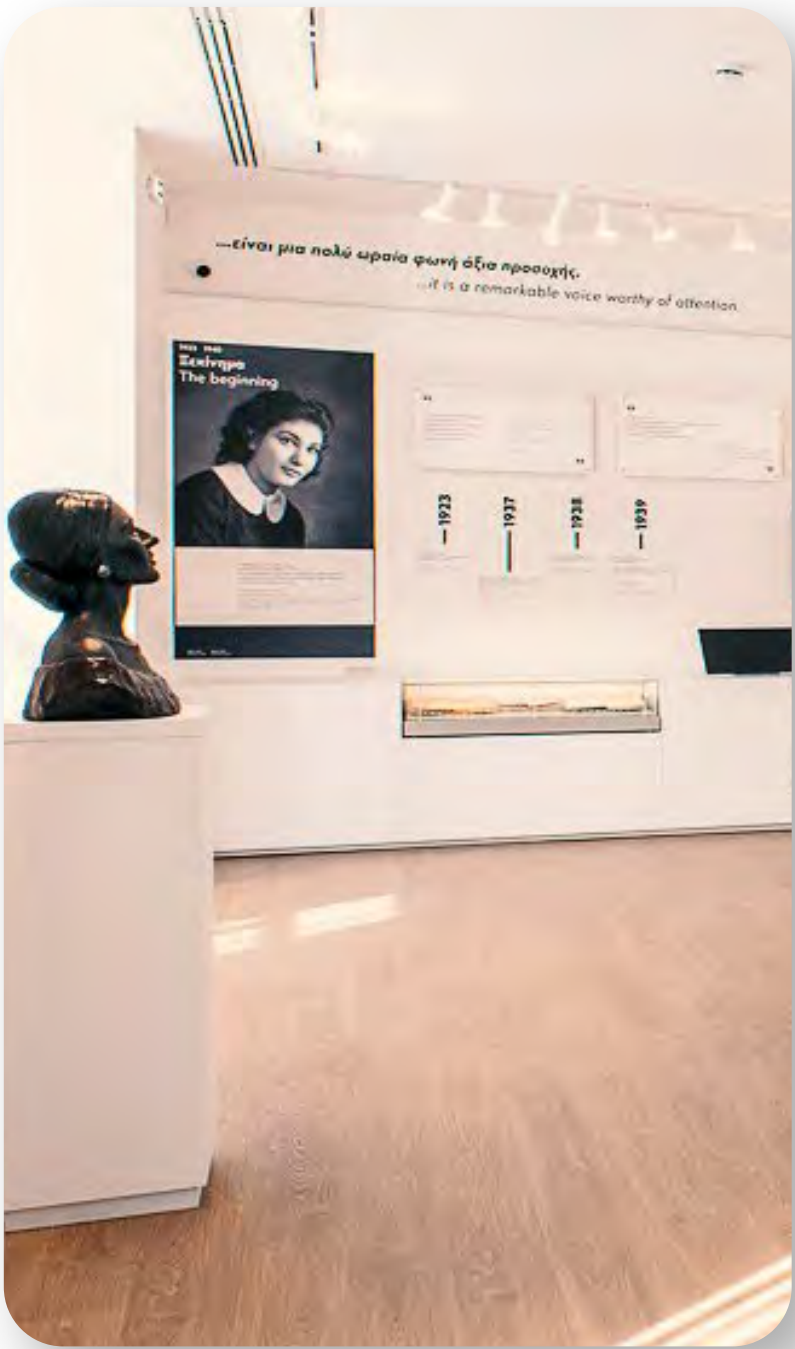
The Voice That Touched the World
